JOB DESCRIPTION

Reporting to the Director of Operations, the Ice Technician is responsible for a variety of day-to-day ice operations while maintaining a high standard for our clients before, during and after ice-related events, along with other building maintenance and operational duties as required.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES (Included, but not limited to)

- ▶ Perform all duties with a superior commitment to safe work practices and actively participate in workplace safety initiatives.
- ▶ Assist in all aspects of arena ice preparation and resurfacing, including scraping, flooding, and preparation/operation of an Ice Resurfacer (Zamboni) and an Ice Edger.
- ▶ Install and remove hockey nets between game periods, with regular inspection and maintenance of the nets.
- ▶ Regularly inspect, clean, and occasionally replace protective glass/boards around the ice surface.
- ▶ Assist with the painting of points, lines, and logos on the ice surface.
- ▶ Assist with facility events set up and tear down as required.
- ▶ Facility preventative maintenance, repairs, and other property support duties.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- ▶ Grade 12 or equivalent education
- ▶ Valid NS Class 5 driver's license
- ▶ A minimum of 2 year experience with the operation of ice resurfacing equipment OR
- ▶ A minimum of 2 year of experience operating heavy or mobile equipment
- ▶ An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered
- ▶ First Aid/CPR certification and WHMIS certification (or willingness to obtain)
- ▶ Must be able to work shifts including evenings, weekends and overnight when required
- ▶ Forklift Certification is an asset
