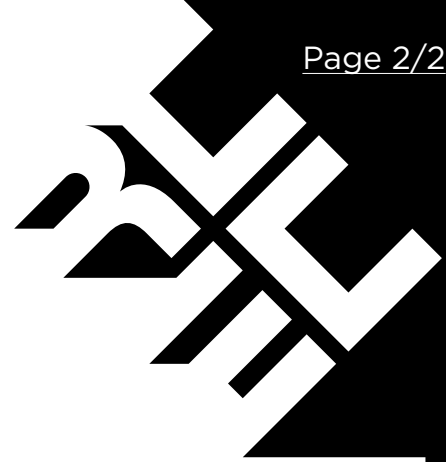

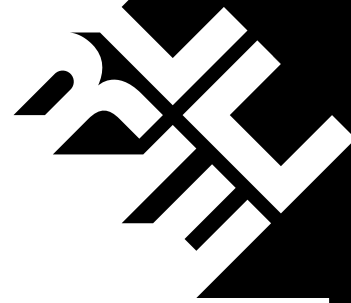
IMPORTANT SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION

We are very excited to be able to offer day camp programming for the 2021 summer season! Each week campers will get to participate in their favourite RECC activities, spend Thursdays at Victoria Park, explore their creative side with crafts, and play goofy games!

- For each day of camp, participants are required to bring the following items:
-water, hat, sunscreen, lunch, snacks, towel, bathing suit, and a craft safe t shirt.
- Drop off location on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday is at the RECC
- Drop off location on Thursday is at Victoria Park near the security office
- All participants must complete a COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire every day with the help of their parent/guardian before being admitted to the day camp.
- Parents/Guardians must maintain a 2-metre distance from others when completing the check in process.
- Every camper and employee's temperature will be taken every morning before they are granted permission to attend camp.
- Parents/visitors will not enter the designated camp area at any time.
- All campers must wear a mask at all times when indoors and not engaged in physical activity.
- Skates will be provided for those who do not have their own. A day camp facilitator will be in contact with each participant in advance of each day camp to ensure everyone has what they need to enjoy their time on the ice.
- SNACKS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED, AND LUNCH WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE.
- To limit sharing supplies, we ask participants to bring any or all the following items:
-coloured pencils or crayons, craft safe scissors, glue stick, pencils/pens, and markers.
These supplies will be provided if needed.
